The Village Hall Management Committee is a registered charity and as well as receiving rental income, fundraising is carried out in order to have the funds available to carry out repairs and pay the bills like gas, electric and insurance.

Residents of Crockenhill over the age of 18 and organisations that regularly hire out the hall are welcome to become involved in the day to day running of the Village Hall.

The meetings while following an agenda and necessary formalities are very friendly and offer a chance to meet and catch up with others.

A wide range of skills and personalities are required to alleviate the pressure from any one individual in looking after our Village Hall and making sure she is kept clean, tidy and safe.

Being a regular member does not carry the same responsibility as that of a Trustee but does give you the right to vote and does encourage you to be involved in decision making about day to day maintenance as well as getting involved in events, like our quiz nights that generate income.

They are held in the Committee room of the Village Hall on the third Wednesday of every month (excluding the months of August and December) starting at 7.30pm and last for a little over an hour.
